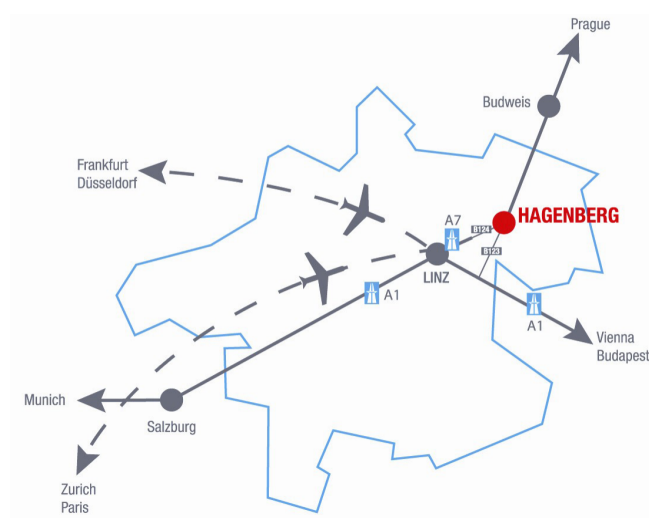

Participation

Please register your (in-person or virtual) participation with ISO. For in-person participants, the organizers need your name to provide name tags and to provide catering during breaks. How to get to Hagenberg



Hagenberg is located in Upper Austria's beautiful Muehlviertel region and only 20 kilometers from Linz, the capital of Upper Austria. If you plan to come by car, you certainly can directly go to Hagenberg. In case you

plan to use a plane or the railway, you will always travel via Linz. For traveling between Linz and the conference venue Hagenberg, see further below.

Linz is characterized by short distances. Many locations near the Danube can be reached on foot. However, sometimes greater distances cannot be avoided, which is why we've summarized some helpful contacts for you here: <https://www.linztourismus.at/en/business/meeting-destination-linz/transfer>.

Via Vienna Airport

The Vienna International Airport (VIE) offers a broad range of direct connections to major airports all around the globe. The train journey time between Vienna Airport (VIE) and Linz is around 1h 50m and covers a distance of around 200km. The fastest train normally takes 1h 40m. The Vienna Airport (VIE) to Linz train service departs directly from Vienna Airport and arrives in Linz Central Station (Linz Hauptbahnhof). The Austrian Railways (ÖBB) offer direct connections from Vienna Airport to Linz Central Station. You can buy tickets here <https://www.oebb.at/en> and here <https://shop.oebbtickets.at/en/ticket>.

Via Linz Airport

The Linz Airport (LNZ) offers direct connections to the transport hubs Frankfurt, Vienna and Düsseldorf. Please visit the website <https://www.linz-airport.com> for more information about the exact flight schedules. The airport is located in Hörsching, which is approximately 12km outside of the city center Linz. Public transportation is an inexpensive alternative to traveling by car or cab. The airport bus No. 601 (see <https://www.ooevv.at/upload/content/downloads/fahrplan/601.pdf>) or the train will take you comfortably to Linz Airport.

Via Munich Airport

Munich Airport offers a broad range of direct connections to major airports around the world. The journey time by train between Munich Airport and Linz is around 3h 45m. Please visit the website <https://www.munich-airport.com> for more information about the exact flight schedules.

Via Salzburg Airport

Salzburg Airport (SBG) offers direct connections to Frankfurt, Hamburg and Düsseldorf. Please visit the website <https://www.salzburg-airport.com/en/flights-arrival/flights/flight-schedule> for more information about the exact flight schedules. The journey from Salzburg Airport to Linz Central Station via Salzburg Central Station takes about 3h and covers 111km.

Via Linz Train Station

The Linz Central Station (Linz Hauptbahnhof) has direct connections to train stations in Germany, Hungary, Switzerland, Italy, and other neighboring countries. A direct and fast connection to the Vienna Central Station (Wien Hauptbahnhof) will take about 1h 15min.

By Car

In case you are planning to come by car on your own, there is both outdoor and underground parking available to participants in and around the Software Park in Hagenberg. Car parks are indicated on the [Campus Map](#) below (see access Basement Parking; unfortunately the capacities are limited).

Accommodation

The hotel primarily intended for the conference is the [Parkhotel](#). It is a three-minute walk from the conference venue. Please book by phone at +43 7236 93050 or via e-mail at office@parkhotel-hagenberg.at with the word *WG21* in the subject. With the reservation code *FH2025* you are entitled to book at the conference rate. The conference rate is EUR 99.00 for a standard room (single or double occupancy), EUR 135.00 for a family room and EUR 165.00 for a business room. The price for breakfast is EUR 17.00. This offer is valid for bookings made from February 6, 2025 to February 18, 2025.

If the [Parkhotel](#) is fully booked---the entire [Parkhotel](#) is reserved exclusively for conference participants---, the Hotel [Sommerhaus](#) in Hagenberg (designated as "Summer Hotel SH1" on the [Campus Map](#) below) will also be available. It is a two-minute walk from the conference venue. Please make a reservation there by telephone on +43 7236 7973 9001 or by e-mail at office.hagenberg@studentenwerk.at with the word *WG21* in the subject line. The room rate is EUR 42.00. The hotel does not offer breakfast, but breakfast at [Campina](#) or [Honeder](#) is only a very short walk away.

An informal evening reception (orientation session) will be held at the [Parkhotel](#) on Sunday, February 9, 2025, at 18:00.

Meals and Grocery Store

We will be offering snacks and drinks during morning and afternoon breaks (water, coffee, tea, fruit juices, bakery, fruits), but do not plan to offer breakfast, lunch, or dinner. Additional Important Information

Climate and Clothing

February in Austria is one of the coldest months of the year. Usually we have less than 0°C (32°F). During the day it may rain, in the night it may freeze. Often it is snowing. So do not forget to bring warm clothing, winter jackets and boots.

Power and Electrical Plugs

Electricity is 230V @ 50 Hz. Austrian plugs have two round pins ([Type C](#) and [Type F](#)).

Smoking

No smoking in public buildings (e.g. airports, train stations, schools, universities, government administration buildings) and on public transport (e.g. trains). At the conference venue you may smoke in the inner courtyard of the Hagenberg Campus. In general smoking is not allowed in restaurants, bars, and cafes.

Currency, Banking, ATM

The official currency of Austria is Euro (EUR, €). Therewith, Austria belongs to the 19 European countries that use the common European money. Banks are located in the surrounding of the congress area.

You may find ATMs within a bank or right outside of the bank building. Entering a bank during closing hours is usually possible with bank cards with a chip. The ATM closest to the congress area is [here](#).

Store Opening Hours

The opening hours of shops vary in Austria. Mostly though, the opening hours during the week are: Monday to Friday from 09:00 to 18:00 and on Saturday they are open until 13:00 or 17:00. On Sundays, stores are usually closed.

The grocery store closest to the conference venue is the "Unimarkt Hagenberg" and is located [here](#). Its opening hours are Monday to Friday from 07:30 to 18:30 and on Saturday from 07:30 to 17:00.

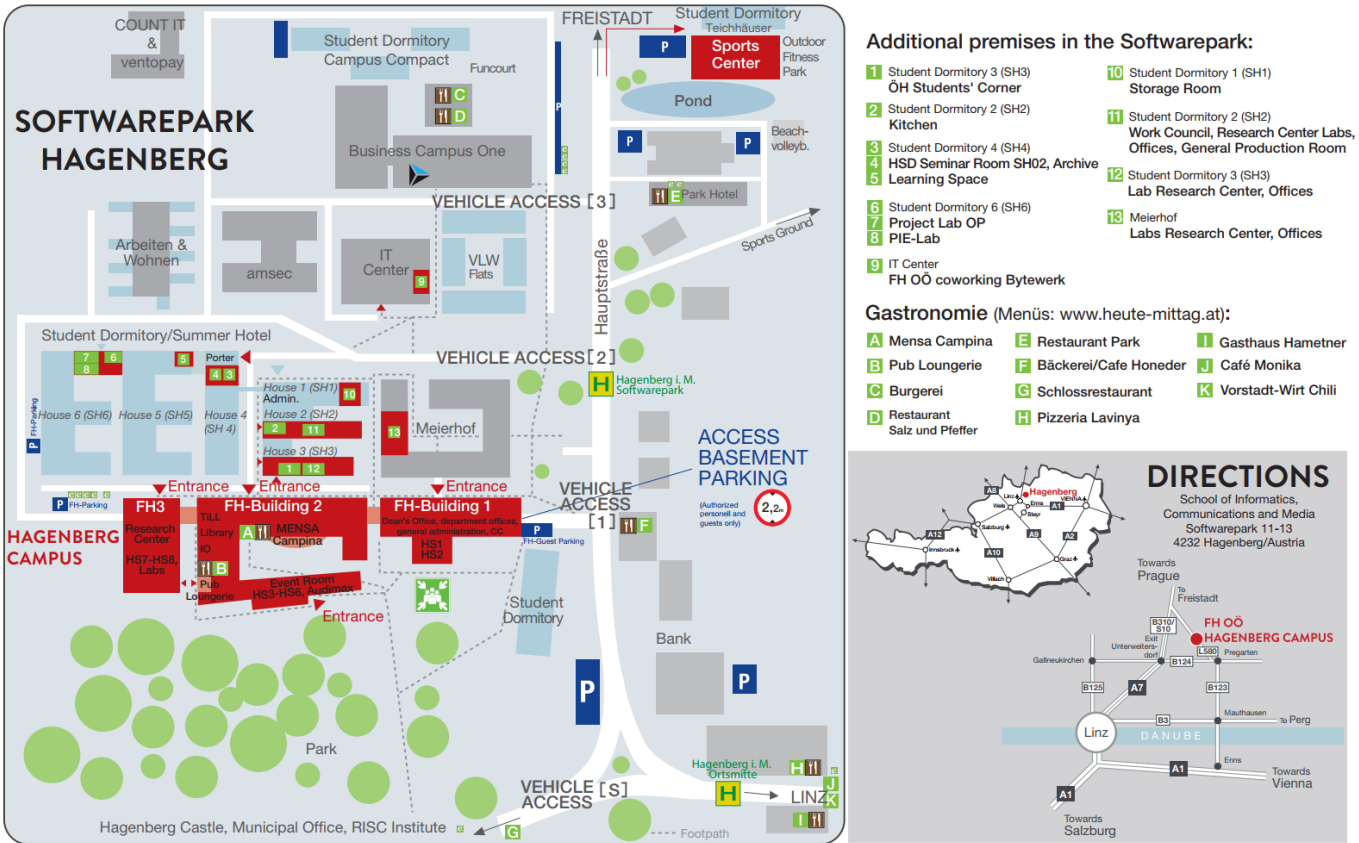
Pharmacy

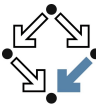
